The USC LIBRARIES RESEARCH AWARD recognizes excellence and creativity in the use of USC Libraries' research collections and services.

WHO

Undergraduate and graduate students are invited to submit a paper or project they have already completed at USC in a for-credit class or independent study during the calendar year.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Students are invited to submit an analytical or creative essay or a research paper completed in connection with for-credit coursework or independent study at USC. A short statement is also required, describing your use of either the libraries' physical or electronic collections or resources. DEADLINE

The deadline for submissions is January 26, 2024.

AWARD RECEPTION

The Libraries hosts a reception in Doheny Library in April, where students receive a certificate and monetary prize.
